Coming up with a unique product/service is often the key to commercial success. Offering the same as your competitors will not give you the best financial return.

Impact on animal use?

Tell us how your venture impacts the use of animals in science. Think about what tests could be replaced, which type of animal, how many?

Tell us why you think your team and your organization is the right entity to take this idea forward successfully.

Think about skills, know-how, patents, assets, relationships, customer bases, etc. Would these give your venture an advantage over competitors? Also think about what you're missing to become successful.

Each team must have a minimum of 3 members, at least 1 member needs to be present during all activities. Also note that the bootcamps are three days each (9h-22h).

For the Proefdiervrij Venture Challenge a participation fee of €2.000 for a team of 3 and €500 for each additional teammember applies. Included in this fee are:

- > two 3-day bootcamps
- > two nights of hotel accommodation for each bootcamp on a single room basis, including meals and beverages
- > course materials
- individual coaching sessions between the two workshops
- > one Challenge session
- > a networking event and award ceremony

Travel expenses are for your own account.

Application Requirements:

A Proefdiervrij Venture Challenge application can be submitted if:

- The team consists of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 people.
- The team wants to market a new product, process or service based on a new technical invention or a new application of pre-existing technology, arising from scientific research. This must fall within the aforementioned scope.
- The team is prepared to cooperate in communication from Proefdiervrij. We take any sensitive/ secret information into account. The emphasis in the communication lies on the motivation to participate, why animal-free research is so important, the expected effects on the use of laboratory animals, etc.
- When the idea includes setting up a company, this must be focused on countries within the EU that have a clear connection with the Netherlands (a Dutch founder for example)
- If the application is made by a start-up, the start-up cannot be older than 5 years
- At least 1 team member is available for each moment mentioned (bootcamps, finals, event)
